Here is some information to assist with your arrival at Murray Bridge and registration for the event.

Check-In and Registration – From 2.00pm – Bridgeport Hotel, 2 Bridge St, Murray Bridge.

This will be in the Main Foyer of the Bridgeport Hotel for Participant Registration, Collection of Accommodation Room Keys, Souvenir Challenge Bag and Merchandise Items.

Hotel Room Amenities

As breakfast is not included in the National Challenge package, you will need to provide your own breakfast.

There are bowls, plates and kettle in the rooms – but no microwave or toaster.

Breakfast packs are available from the Hotel Front desk – if required – or there are supermarkets close by if supplies are required.

Please note that due to our accommodation arrangements with the Hotel – there is no food or drinks to be booked to the room – please pay for these at the bar or front counter at time of purchase – Thank You.

Welcome BBQ Dinner - 05:30pm – 08:30pm - RSL Bar and Grill, 2 Ross Rd, Murray Bridge East.

A welcome BBQ will be waiting for the participants to catch up with friend and members, have a meal and cold drink to start the 2026 National Challenge. This will be ongoing from 5.30pm to 8.30pm to allow for the travellers to arrive, settle in and grab a bite to eat. It's just a short walk over the bridge.

Sprite/Midgets/Support Vehicles/Trailer Parking

Sprite and Midgets will be parked in a locked, secure car park under the Hotel, with access for guests only. Support or Tow vehicles can be parked in the surrounding car park alongside the Hotel.

Those towing Sprites and Midgets can park nearby the Hotel and then unload and locate the Spridget in the underground car park.

Secure Trailer parking is available for those who have towed their vehicles.

This will be at the **45 Army Cadet Unit, 19 Caroline St, Murray Bridge.**

Opening times for trailer parking will be communicate closer to the event – with a couple of times available, allowing you to unload your vehicle, then park the trailer
